Today's Mass Readings: FOURTH SUNDAY of EASTER

Acts of the Apostles 4: 8-12, 17-19; Psalm 117; 1 John 3: 1-2; John 10: 11-18

First Reading: arraigned before the Sanhedrin, the supreme court of the Jews, Peter courageously and dauntlessly proclaims that the name of Jesus Christ is the only name by which we can be saved.

Psalm: "the stone which the builders rejected has become the corner stone" - so our Lord, rejected by His people but raised up by God to become our saviour. In the Temple of the Lord we each sing our praises and thanksgivings to God who has so loved us

Second Reading: we shall be like God because we shall see him as he really is.

Gospel: Jesus describes Himself as the good (or model) shepherd, because He is willing to die to protect the sheep (unlike a hired man) and because He knows His sheep intimately.

In laying down His life and rising again at His resurrection the Son is obeying the command or will of the Father. Fr Davíd
