Today's Mass Readings: THIRTEENTH SUNDAY (Year B)

27th June 2021

Wisdom 1:13-15, 2: 23-24; Psalm 29; 2 Corinthians 8:7, 9, 13-15; Mark 5: 21-43

First Reading: this reading, chosen to accompany the Gospel, teaches that God wills life and indeed did "make man imperishable", but death comes from the devil.

The **Psalm** is a thanksgiving for recovery from sickness.

Second Reading: St Paul is exhorting the Corinthian church to give generously to his fund for the poor Christians in Jerusalem. He quotes Exodus 16:18, when the manna gathered by the Israelites in the wilderness was more than enough for everyone: this foreshadows the love of Christ in His members, which supplies the needs of each without deficiency or excess.

Gospel: the interwoven stories (so typical of Mark) of the raising of Jairus' daughter and the healing of a woman with a haemorrhage. Jesus demonstrates his authority over incurable illness and even death. His Lordship knows no bounds. Fr David
