Today's Mass Readings: TWENTY-SECOND SUNDAY of the YEAR (C)

28th August 2022

Sirach 3: 19-21, 30-31; Psalm 67; Hebrews 12: 18-19, 22-24; Luke 14: 1, 7-14

As is usually the case the First Reading contains a prefiguring of the Gospel message: God wants us to be humble, not proud.

Psalm: in his goodness God is concerned for the poor, not the wealthy or important.

Second Reading: an image of the parousia, the Day of the Lord, the second coming of Christ.

Gospel: Jesus has a Sabbath meal with a Pharisee and his guests, who scrutinise Him closely. A Sabbath meal is supposed to be an anticipation of the banquet in the kingdom, but Jesus criticises them for their haughtiness and lack of humility.

Jesus' advice - to invite the poor and disabled rather than VIPs or the rich - must have been as puzzling then as it is now. What we have to do is to work out what this means in practice for us.
