THIS WEEK

Christmas Octave

This Solemnity is so important - second only to the annual celebration of the Paschal Mystery at Easter - that it has a full week (an Octave) of celebration, with several important Feasts, including the Solemnity of St Thomas of Canterbury, the patron of our Parish, Church, and School, each with their proper Readings at Mass.

Fr Peter will be away on his Christmas break this week, visiting his family.

Crib Offerings

The donations at each Crib will be sent to the Knights of the Holy Sepulchre of Jerusalem, to help support the church in the Holy Land. The Knights support parishes, schools, clinics and hospitals, Bethlehem University, and the diocesan Seminary, mainly in the West Bank.

Monday and Tuesday

As these are Bank Holidays Holy Mass at St Thomas's is at 12:00 noon. The Parish Office is closed on Monday and Tuesday. There is no Adoration at St Thomas's on Monday or Tuesday.

Monday is the Feast of St Stephen, the first Martyr and Patron of Altar Servers. Tuesday is the Feast of St John, the Apostle and Evangelist, known as the 'Beloved Disciple'.

Wednesday

is the Feast of the Holy Innocents, Martyrs. Holy Mass at the normal times at St Thomas's (8:00am) and at Otford (10:00am).

Thursday: St Thomas's Day

is the Solemnity of our Patron. Holy Mass at 10:00am at Borough Green and 12:00 noon in St Thomas's. This Mass will be followed by refreshments in the Parish Room, to celebrate our Patron's Day. Do come along and join in the festivities.

Friday and Saturday

Friday is the Feast of the Holy Family, with Holy Mass at 8:00am at St Thomas's and 10:00am at West Kingsdown. Note that as it is in the Christmas Octave the normal Friday abstinence does not apply; in other words you may eat meat this Friday.

On Saturday - the Seventh Day in the Octave - Holy Mass is at 9:30am as usual, followed by the Holy Rosary and Confessions. Confessions are also heard between 5:15 and 5:45pm.
