Today's Mass Readings: Sixteenth Sunday (Year A)

Wisdom 12: 13, 16-19, Psalm 85, Romans 8: 26-27, Matthew 13: 24-43

First Reading: this passage is like a hymn to God, who has absolute sovereignty but who exercises it with leniency and forbearance.

Psalm: as so often, the psalm repeats the basic message of the First Reading: God is a god of mercy and compassion.

Second Reading: when we pray we think that we are taking the initiative, but in fact it is the Holy Spirit in us enabling us to pray.

Gospel: today's Gospel contains a series of parables about the kingdom of heaven. Are they about the world, or the Church, or Heaven? Whichever way we take them, the central point is that God is at work, even if we do not see it, and any growth in grace (for us as individuals or for the church) is a free gift from God.
