Today's Mass Readings: The TRANSFIGURATION of the LORD (Year A) 6th August 2023 Daniel 7: 9-10, 13-14, Psalm 96, 2 Peter 1: 16-19, Matthew 17: 1-9

First Reading: the prophet Daniel has a vision of 'one like a son of man', a title ascribed by Christians to Jesus Christ. The divine figure has the same 'white as snow' robe as Jesus in the Gospel.

Psalm: this may be based on the appearance of God on Mount Sinai in *Exodus* 19, but if we apply it to Jesus it describes His kingship and His glory.

Second Reading: Peter was an evewitness to the Transfiguration, which he regards as important because it shows that the Christian message is based on historical events, not myths, it demonstrates that God does act in the world, and it reveals that Jesus is truly the Son of God.

Gospel: in his account of the Transfiguration Matthew calls it a 'vision'; this doesn't mean it was a psychological experience - like a hallucination - but that it was a God-given ability to see what humans couldn't normally see. The details indicate that this is what is called a Christophany, that is to say it manifests Jesus as the Messiah, and a Theophany, that is it also reveals His Divinity.

Is it significant that the three apostles - Peter, James, and John - reappear together only in Gethsemane? If Christ's followers wish to share in His glory, they must be prepared to participate in His suffering.
